Spirituality and a Sense of Purpose

Developing a sense of purpose can be deeply spiritual. New research by Dr. Lisa Miller, shows that teenagers with a greater sense of spirituality report higher levels of purpose and meaning.

To have a sense of purpose, it is essential that you know yourself: what you want from your life, not what others want for you, or what is expected of you, but what actually makes you come alive.

Dr. Miller's research reveals that humans are universally equipped with a capacity for spirituality and that our brains become more resilient and robust as a result of it.

• An engaged spiritual life enhances grit, optimism, and resilience while providing insulation against addiction, trauma, and depression.



I wanted to give you a brief explanation of the above advertised event on May 19th. Our goal for that evening is to provide an update on where we are in the process and answer any questions that you have as we work our way through the process of deciding what's next for our two churches. Throughout the process, many of you have asked questions and we've done our best to answer what we can, whether in personal conversation, in the newsletter, or in announced updates such as in the congregational meeting back in February. However, we know that we haven't been able to answer all the questions, and you may have new questions that have popped up over the last few months. To do that, on May 19th we are going to put leaders from both churches on the stage at Sunrise and work our way through your submitted questions together. That means if you have a question that you'd like us to address, you need to submit that question to us as outlined in the note above. We want to be efficient that evening, and we figure that many of you have similar questions, so we will organize the submitted questions in order to provide a coherent presentation of questions and answers. Please know that no final decision has been made, though we have begun to discuss what a merger would look like in practice and what would be required if this is the route we go. We value your prayers and feedback as we work our way through this conversation as we seek to see where Jesus is leading us.
